Build a Birdhouse

Birdhouses give birds a safe place to live and build their nests. Follow these easy steps to build one of your own:

- Have an adult help you cut pieces of wood for the sides, roof, front, back, and bottom of your birdhouse.
- Ask an adult to help assemble the pieces.
- Drill a hole in the front of your birdhouse. Use sandpaper to smooth any rough edges.

 Hang your birdhouse outside. Soon, a bird may move in.
